NEW HAMILTON U12 FOOTBALL COMPETITION REGISTRATION DAY - SUNDAY 26th APRIL GRAY ST PS SPORTS STADIUM, HAMILTON @ 10.30AM

A new Under 12 football competition is about to be launched in Hamilton. Established in conjunction with the Victorian Country Football League, AFL Victoria and the Western Border FL, the four team competition will be played on Sunday mornings prior to the Hamilton Junior FL U14 matches.

The four new teams will be known as the Redbacks (Essendon jumpers) Pumas (St Kilda) Scorpions (Collingwood) and Stingrays (Richmond).

Even though the players will compete in existing HJFL colours, the teams will not be aligned to any

particular Hamilton club. Venues will be rotated throughout the HJFL club home grounds, and all matches will be played under the AFL modified rules guidelines.

This is a great way for kids to participate in an organised competition structure prior to the step up to U14s.

A registration/information day (including free BBQ) will be held this Sunday 26 April at Gray St

Primary School Sports Stadium commencing at 10.30 am.

The registration fee for the whole season is just \$20, which includes insurance cover.

Intending players must currently be in either Grade 5 or Grade 6 at primary school, and girls are
