Wheeze when you exercise?

If you experience any of the above ask your pharmacist or doctor about a lung health check.

Asthma: 10 things to tell your doctor

Symptoms

- 1. If you wake up coughing, wheezing or breathless
- 2. If you struggle to keep up with normal activity

Triggers

- 3. Anything that seems to trigger/make your asthma worse
- 4. What you do about your triggers and whether this helps

Medication

- 5. How often you take your blue reliever puffer
- 6. How often you take your preventer medication
- 7. How you use your device
- 8. If you are using any other medications or complementary therapies

Asthma plan

- 9. I would like an asthma action plan
- 10. I would like a regular asthma review
