Milo T20 Big Blast Cricket Tournament

On Tuesday 10th November, students in grades 5 and 6 will travel to Warrnambool to participate in the local qualifying event of the Milo T20 Big Blast cricket event. In previous years we have joined in on the local event in Hamilton, however due to a clash of events, this year we need to participate at a different venue.

Koorie Cultural Connect Day

On Friday 13th November, we will be hosting a large number of Koorie students at our school for a Koorie Cultural Connect Day. These are held once each term at various schools within the Warrnambool Network where Koorie students attend, and in total (including our own students) we expect around 150 children at our school on this day.

Children in grades 5 and 6 will participate in science based programs involving EarthEd and BioLab, two Education Department science specialist initiatives, whilst children in grades Prep to 4 will participate in activities involving aboriginal dance, art, dreamtime stories, spear throwing and some sporting activities.

We will require some help on the day to assist with cooking of a BBQ. This is shaping as a great experience for all students involved, with more information to follow closer to the date.

After School Sport

Our first session took place last night with the sport of focus this term being tennis. There are still plenty of spaces available so if you haven't done so, please fill out the enrolment form from last week's newsletter and have your child participate from next week onwards. Our Friday sessions, during school hours, for children in Prep-2 will be in the sport of basketball and will involve coach Bobby Cunningham, a high-profile basketballer from the Warrnambool area who has a wealth of knowledge and experience to pass on to the students. Students in grades 3 to 6 this term will focus on cricket and table tennis.

2016 Prep Transition

Local kinder students joined us again today as a part of our annual transition program, where they spent a session in Performing Arts with Miss Pemberton, followed by activities in the Prep classroom with Miss Thomson and students. It is very pleasing to see these younger students grow and develop from session to session, as they become more comfortable and accustomed with our programs and structures.

The next transition session will take place on Wednesday November 11th, between 11:30am and 1:30pm, with the final session being a whole day experience on Tuesday 8th December, as a part of the state-wide transition day.


